Funds to assist in paying heating/energy bills.

Who is it for?

Wage earners
Self-employed people
Senior/retired people
All income eligible households

Who can apply?

Home owners
Renters who pay heating/electric costs
Renters with heat included in their rent

*To apply at MVAC you must reside in one of the following counties: Blue Earth, Brown, Faribault, Le Sueur, Martin, Nicollet, Sibley, Waseca, Watonwan.

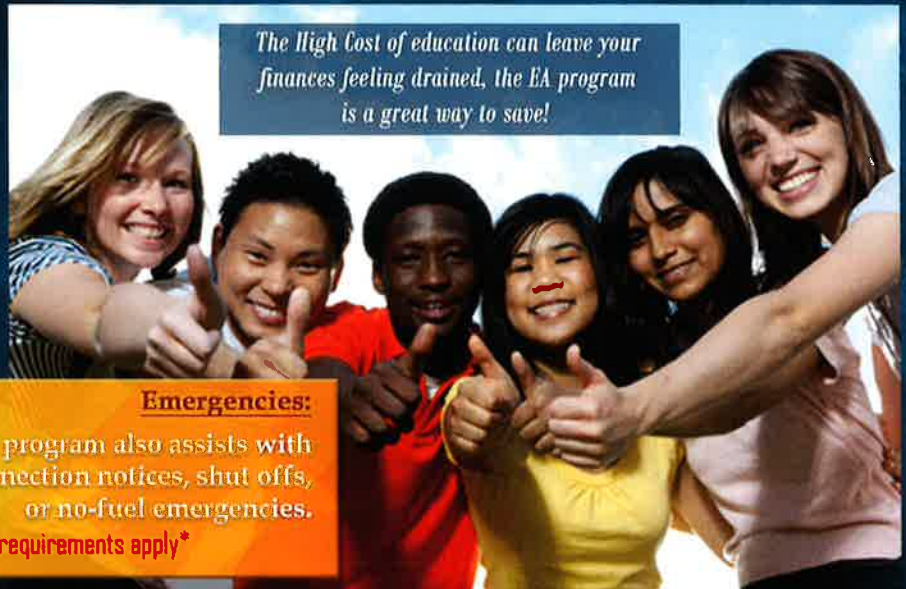
